Persistence is the Key!

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TIP 01

UNDERSTAND THE REASONS

Carefully review the feedback provided.

Understand the specific reasons for the decision.

TIP 02

REVISE YOUR PROPOSAL

01

Utilize the feedback by making necessary revisions to your proposal.

02

Ensure that you address any weaknesses or gaps highlighted during the evaluation process.

03

Identify the specific weaknesses, update your proposal and clarify goals, impact and budget.

TIP 03

CONCISE & EASY TO UNDERSTAND

Ensure your proposal is:

- Concise
- Well-structured
- Easy to understand
- Supported by strong evidence

Also:

- Highlight your project's unique value.
- Demonstrate the project's positive impact on stakeholders or the community.

Lack of clarity is the most common reason for rejection.

TIP 04

BUDGET JUSTIFICATION

- Lacks on budget justification
- Eligibility criteria
- Missing paperwork

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TIP 05

CONSULT EXPERTS

Seek advice from experts or consultants who specialize in securing funding for tourism projects.

TIP 06

NETWORK & COLLABORATE

- Connect with industry peers
- Attend workshops and conferences
- Seek partnerships
- Cultivate relationships and engage in dialogue

TIP 07

SEEK ALTERNATIVE FUNDING SOURCES

Explore other sources of funding from relevant programs of the EU.
